

## When the Messenger of Allah ([]) said: "Sami'allāhu liman hamidah (Allah hears whoever praises him)," none of us would bend his back until the Prophet ([]) had fallen in prostration. We would then fall in prostration right after him

'Abdullah ibn Yazīd al-Khatmi reported: Al-Barā'—and he is not a liar—said to me: When the Messenger of Allah (□) said: "Sami'allāhu liman hamidah (Allah hears whoever praises him)," none of us would bend his back until the Prophet (□) had fallen in prostration. We would then fall in prostration right after him.

Al-Barā' ibn 'Āzib (may Allah be pleased with him) truthfully reported that when the Prophet (
| raised his head from bowing and said: Sami'allāhu liman hamidah (Allah hears whoever praises Him), those behind him would remain standing, and none of them would bend his back to prostrate until the Prophet (
| had placed his forehead on the ground—then they would all prostrate after him.
